



2 Installation Notes

APCO is usually installed on the supply side duct just above the air system but can also be installed on the return side if necessary.

The APCO unit should be oriented so that the air flows past the **UV Light** first then into the **Matrix Element.**


If a second optional UV lamp is used (APCO Dual) select a location inside the air system that will allow it to shine on the greatest surface area or the area with the most evident microbial growth. To install the secondary UV light use the **Optional 2nd Remote UV Light Installation Instructions** provided with APCO Dual.

Typical installations include:

- A APCO single in air handler
- B APCO dual in air handler
- **G** APCO single in Furnace
- APCO dual in Furnace

3 Join Matrix Element To Power Unit

Attach the Matrix Element to the Power Unit using (2) Self-Tapping Screws and (2) Locking Nuts.



4 Cut Hole In Duct Using Template





Use scissors to cut out center of paper template (pick circular or linear). Trace cut-line onto duct using template.





Cut hole in duct using a cutting tool appropriate for the duct material.




Attach Power Unit to Duct & Mount UV Lamp

- 1. Fit the Matrix Element through the hole cut in the duct so that the Power Unit lies flush against the duct surface. To attach the Power Unit to metal ducts use 4 Self-tapping Screws. For soft duct materials use Duct **Rivets** and duct tape or scrim tape and mastic.
- 2. Insert UV Lamp
- 3. Mount UV Lamp using (2) Quick Nuts and attach lamp connector (be sure to align the four connector pins)
- 4. Replace Power Unit cover







6 Connecting to Power

IMPORTANT

Before connecting to power confirm which APCO model is being installed. Turn off main power source before installation. Model information is printed on the **Power Unit** cover.



IMPORTANT!


Systems with high 24 VAC loads may require the installation of a separate 24 VAC transformer to power the UV light.

Always use a separate 24 VAC transformer with "communicating" air systems and all APCO Dual (TUV-APCO-DER) models.

Draws 16 VA, may need to do load calculation: Volts under load X Amps under load.

7 Lamp Replacement

The germicidal UV lamp in APCO needs to be replaced periodically. TUVL-100E lamps should be replaced every year. TUVL-200E should be replaced every 2 years. Note: UV lamps will continue to emit visible light but lose germicidal effectiveness over time. You can upgrade to a 2 year lamp with your existing APCO Power Unit.



The optional Fresh-Aire Remote UV Light works with the APCO system for enhanced disinfection, reduced system maintenance, and improved indoor air quality.

2 Installation Notes

Before installing the Fresh-Aire Remote UV Light it is necessary to determine the optimal mounting location inside the air system. First, look for the area with the heaviest mold growth. Also consider a location that will allow the germicidal UV light to shine on the greatest surface area.

Some typical mounting locations:

- A Supply-side duct
- **B** At the blower
- Across top of coils
- Coil face
- Coil "A" plate
- Return-side duct





② Air Handler Interior Surface Installation




metal surface or remove the magnet and hardmount the bracket using the **self-tapping screws** provided. Use foil tape to close the cut in the insulation.

4. Use plastic **quick-nuts** to attach the **UV lamp** to the **"Z" bracket** as shown.











- **1.** Snap the **"Z" bracket** apart by bending.
- 2. Drill a 1" hole in the "A"-plate or duct then attach the smaller piece of the bracket using the self-tapping screws.
- Insert the UV lamp into the hole then use the plastic quick-nuts to attach the UV lamp to the "Z" bracket as shown.




Remote UV Light Configuration




7 Sight Glass Installation

- Find a suitable location on the outside of the duct-work near the UV Lamp installation and apply the Fresh-Aire UV® warning/lamp replacement sticker.
- **2.** Drill a ½" hole through the orange circle on the sticker. Press the UV safety viewport into hole.
- **3.** Turn on the power and use the sight glass to confirm that the UV Lamp is operating.




6 Remote UV Lamp Connection

- When all the other components are properly installed connect the UV Lamp cable to the APCO Power supply cable.
- **2.** Make sure the flanges are aligned and then push the connectors firmly together. A tight connection ensures a proper water-resistant seal.



10 Lamp Replacement

The germicidal UV lamp in the **Fresh-Aire Remote UV Light** needs to be replaced periodically. TUVL-100 and TUVL-100-OS (odor control) lamps should be replaced every year. TUVL-200 and TUVL-200-OS should be replaced every 2 years. Note: UV lamps will continue to emit visible light but lose germicidal effectiveness over time. You can upgrade to a 2 year and/or odor control lamp with your existing power supply.
